PRODUCT SAFETY ACT (ACT V of 2001)

The Cosmetic Products (Amendment) Regulations, 2003

IN exercise of the powers conferred by article 39 of the Product Safety Act, the Minister for Economic Services has, on the advice of the Malta Standards Authority, made the following regulations:

- 1. The title of this Order is the Cosmetic Products (Amendment) Citation. Regulations, 2003, and shall be read and construed as one with the Cosmetic Products Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the principal L.N. 143 of 2002. regulations".
- 2. For regulation 5(2) (i) of the principal regulations, there shall Amends regulation be substituted the following:

5(2) of the principal regulations

"ingredients or combinations of ingredients tested on animals after 31st December 2003 in order to meet the requirements of these regulations.".

3. For regulation 7(1) (c) of the principal regulations, there shall Amends regulation be substituted the following:

7(1) of the principal regulations.

"the method of manufacture complying with the good manufacturing practice laid down by Community law or, failing that, laid down by Maltese law; the person responsible for manufacture or importation must possess an appropriate level of professional qualification or experience:".

4. In the entry for 'Hydroquinone' in item 14 of the Third Amends the Third Schedule, item '(b)' in column c, the figure of '2 %' in column (d) and Schedule principal item '(b)' in column f are deleted.
